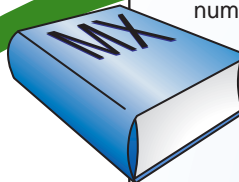
### Post Office Name Server

The name server holds the MX record which has the IP number where your website is hosted (cf Apartment address) and the ISP mail server who handles your email account (cf Postie).



### Directory MX Record

A directory records where you live and where to send your mail.



### Postie ISP

The postie delivers your mail to your mailbox.

Your ISP (Internet Service Provider) transfers any emails from your website (eg: info@yourwebsite.com) into your email account.



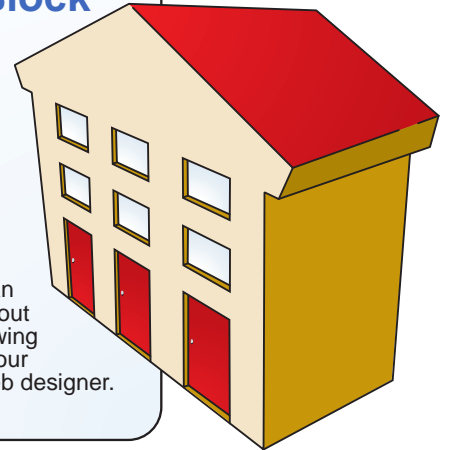

An interior decorator can design the look and layout of your apartment following your instructions. For your website, you have a web designer.



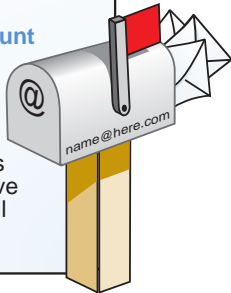
